UNIVERSITY PROFESSOR

<u>Purpos</u>e

The title of University Professor is reserved for scholar teachers whose extraordinary professional accomplishments merit special commendation.

<u>Eligibility</u>

Through this rank the University seeks to hothouse who teach and search in multiple disciplines, those who have made unusual tributions to sociest, or those who have achieved national or international distince. Tenured professors at Pepperdine are eligible for consideration, as well as wrigh hired faculty who meet the stringent requirements for the award. Those selected for the University Professor (UP) rank will be among the very best in their field and fully supportive of the University's distinctive mission. Candidates will safe the following criteria:

- x renown (national and/or tiernational distinction)
- x demonstrated excellence in scholarship
- x demonstrated excellence in teaching vislenced by commitment to mentoring student scholars
- x preeminence in a field of study or excellence in two or more disciplines (potentially able to teacin two or more schools)
- x support for the University mission
- x full professors or holdingredentials that qualify orte be a full professor

Review Process

1. The nominating process is open. Any faculty mber, division/department chair, or

<u>Tenure</u> For lateral hires nominated for the ra**ek**tablished tenure practices and policies will be followed.

Number of positions

The honor will be relatively rare. Generally, **mo**re than 1 to 2 per cent of the tenured faculty will hold this rank.

Funding

Ideally, University Professorships will beended by new resources. The new fund-raising campaign, for example, will endow neacfulty positions, some of which may be designated for University Professors.

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
